19 ministries receive donations at Vero Beach Christian Business Association's 'Celebration of Giving' luncheon



The Vero Beach Christian Business Association finished the last half of 2017 by giving back to the community in a variety of tangible ways.

Let's count them: school supply drives for Dasie Bridegewater Hope Center and Feed the Lambs; collecting items for our military troops for the "Holidays for Heroes" program coordinated by Military Moms Prayer Group; a food drive for Epic Missions; and toys for Little Birthday Angels.
